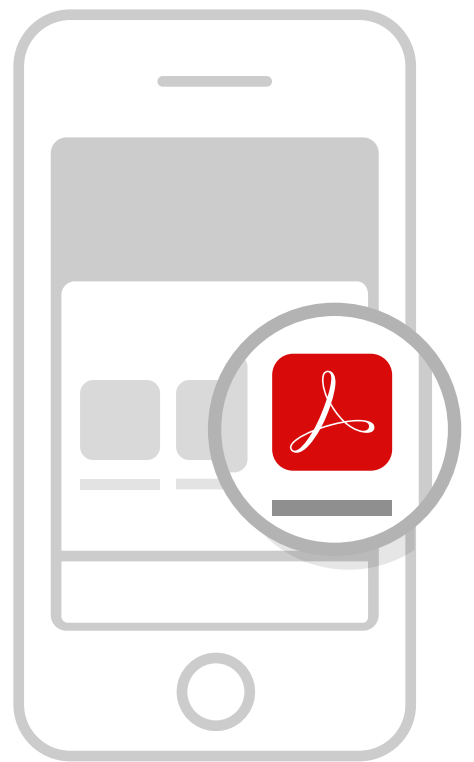
- 01 Open a PDF from mail

Open a PDF from mail

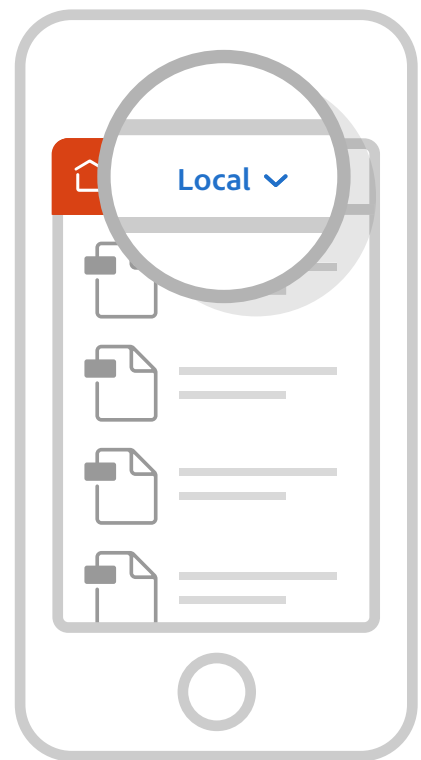
When you encounter a PDF file,
tap on the Share icon and choose
“Copy to Adobe Acrobat Reader.”

Get recent files from My Documents

Tap the file list menu in the top bar to see your recently viewed files, or access files stored in Adobe Document Cloud.



Links – Intro to Accessible PDF

There are three ways in which links are indicated within a document. Using the full URL, using an abbreviated URL, and embedding the link the text of the document (preferred).

Each approach presents unique challenges in making a PDF accessible to the screen reader user.

Embedding the link in the text of the document is the best approach as it provides the most readable and understandable form of the link. The following sentences demonstrate three ways to add a hyperlink to a document.

Embedded Hyperlink

Shortened URL

Full URL

A correctly tagged link has the <Link> tag, text associated with the link, and a Link – OBJR tag (the order of the last two is irrelevant).

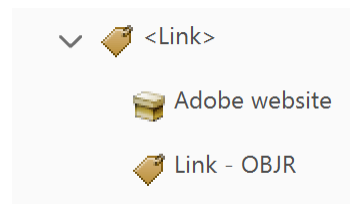


Figure 1: Link tagged in the order of <Link> tag, link text, and Link - OBJR tag

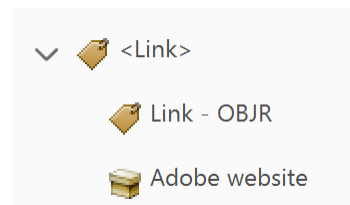
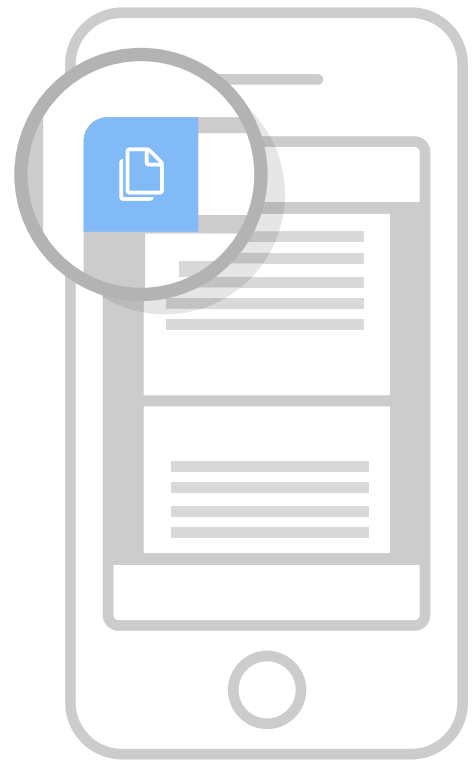


Figure 2:: Link tagged in the order of <Link> tag, Link - OBJR tag, and link text

Read documents anywhere

Files open in the Viewer. From here you can scroll and zoom, change the view mode, and search for text.

Use tools on your PDF

Tap the tool switcher to see the full menu of tools including Comment and Export PDF.
