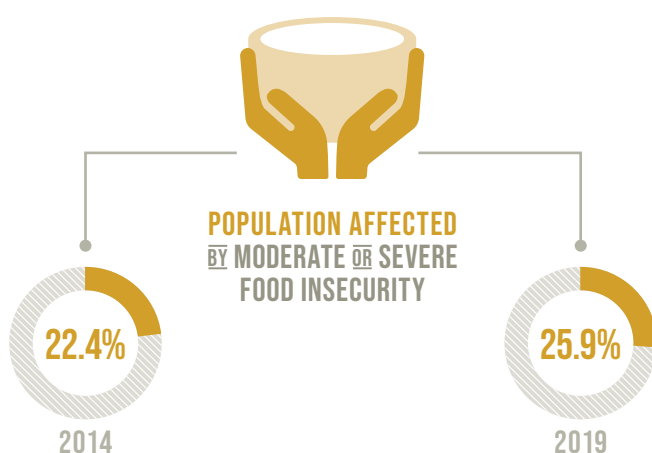

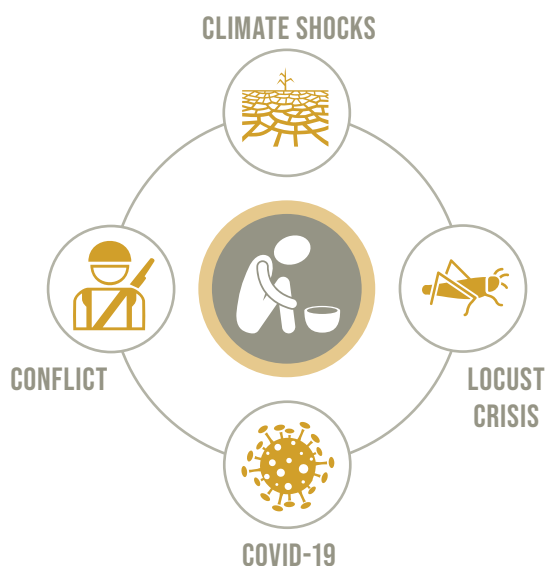

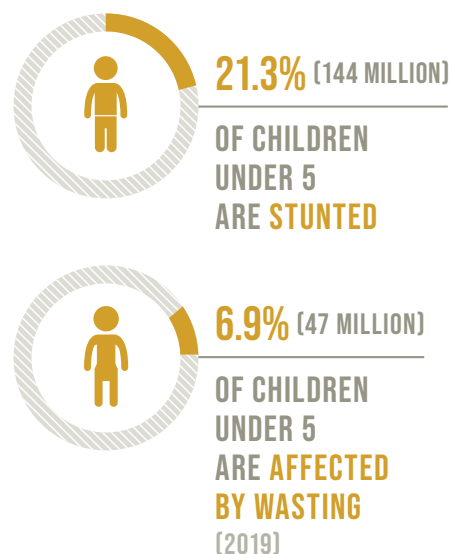


COVID-19 IMPLICATIONS
